## MINUTES

## ASAA

The state has 4 meetings a year. Doug handed out a 2 page synopsis of what is covered at each meeting.

The proposal to have 4A wrestling go to the 3A season that was brought forward by Lyle/Sitka failed at the State meeting.

The State executive board is working on a new policy that only items supported by that school's region may be brought to the table.

The latest proposed policy and bylaws changes that just came out, need to be returned no later than this week. Doug asked that everyone vote to support the changes.

Derrick Peterson from ASBA is now putting together an ASSETS book for coaches, players & parents. The ASAA board supports this project.

The 10% rule for classification of schools is being looked at. Doug supports that this policy should apply to 4A also.

## BASEBALL

A new baseball schedule was discussed, Craig stated that they couldn't play the games scheduled over the Music Fest weekend. Doug also stated that he was unable to talk to his baseball coach about the changes.

Sandi brought forward several issues that had been raised concerning the cost of travel to POW and the quality of their field.

Sandi Wagner also brought forward a proposal by Juneau's baseball coach to extend that season by two weeks.

**Motion: That Region V ask the state to start the baseball season 2 weeks earlier.

## SOFTBALL

Sandy Wagner presented a proposal from Juneau's softball baseball coach to move the Music Fest two weeks earlier so spring sports have more weekends to play. Both Barry & Darold felt that this change would greatly impact music programs across the region. It was decided that the issue would be forward to the music teachers and that a decision be made after that feedback is given.

### **3A/4A BASKETBALL**

Marcellus from Mt Edgecumbe handed out the reserved seating for each school.

Lyle from Sitka handed out a packet that covers the housing for the tournament. Return the survey that was included ASAP.

### **CHEERLEADING**

Ronelle stated that there is a new competition at State basketball for squads that want to compete even if their school's basketball team did not make state. The competition will be the Wednesday.

### **TRACK**

**Motion: Approve Track Schedule. Sandi Wagner PASSED**

Juneau's track meet will end early on saturday. morning to accommodate schools with prom.

### **WRESTLING**

Lyle passed out a wrestling season proposal to switch wrestling to a two classification sport similar to that currently used for football, which is based on school size (small/850, large/851 +). Currently students are having to choose between wrestling and basketball. Lyle asked that the region support this proposal.

**Motion: That the Region support wrestling be switched to a two classification.
